 - As requested by parent/guardian and/or teacher with administration.

- 5. Provide parent/guardian opportunities to volunteer and participate in their child's class or school and to observe classroom activities.

 - ➤ Parent/Guardian Handbook is given to parents/guardians on the first day of school or the first day the child attends Camarena Elementary School.
