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Hybrid Model Important FACTS

- Students may be reassigned to a different teacher.
- Every effort will be made to keep siblings in the same Cohort.
- No changes will be made to classroom assignments within the first 3 weeks of the start of the Hybrid Model.
- The campus will be open the day before the start date for the Hybrid Model (So families can see where their child's classroom is located).
- Visitors and Volunteers are not allowed on campus (except for Special Education testing).

Arrival – Supervision is Provided

- Morning Cohort arrival anytime between 8:00 am– 8:20 am.
- Afternoon Cohort arrival anytime between 11:50 am – 12:10 pm.
- Students may report to campus either by vehicle drop off or walking.
- Students may be asked to wash their hands upon entering the classroom.
- No bikes, scooters, heelies, skateboards are allowed on campus while in the Hybrid Model.
- The first week of the Hybrid Model, parents may walk their child to their classroom door but must wear a mask and stay 6ft apart from others.
- After the first week of the Hybrid Model **NO ONE** other than staff and students will be allowed on the campus until dismissal.
- *Students should not arrive earlier than the schedule arrival time as there is no supervision. Please always keep younger siblings in strollers or with you. NO PETS!*

LATE ARRIVALS/TARDIES/ABSENCES

- Students who arrive or are picked up late will need to report to the Robo Tent at the front of the school.
- Plan medical appointments after school when possible.
- If your child is absent, call the school Health/Attendance Office that day to report the absence.
- If you failed to call the Health/Attendance Office, please send a note with your child on the day he/she returns to school. This note should include the date of absence and reason.
- Chronic attendance issue may result in your child being placed back into a Distance Learning class.

Dismissal - Supervision is Provided

- Morning Cohort: Kinder 10:50 am and Grades 1-6 11:00 am
- Afternoon Cohort: Kinder 2:35 pm and Grades 1-6 2:45 pm
- Students who walk home will need to leave the campus
- Students not picked up on time will be brought to the Tent at the front of the school and wait for pick up.
- Students who are late arriving or being picked up more than 3 times may be placed back into the Distance Learning program.

EARLY DISMISSAL/LEAVING SCHOOL GROUNDS

- Students are not allowed to leave the school building and/or grounds with anyone other than their parent or guardian, or a designated adult who is listed on the student's emergency card.
- Students must be signed out in the office by the parent or designee prior to leaving the school grounds.
- Unfamiliar individuals will be required to show a picture identification to office personnel before the child can be released.
- Parents and designees will be asked to wait in the office while school personnel call the child to the office. Students will only be called to the school office upon arrival of the person picking the child up.



Safety Protocols

- Class size will be no more than 12 students.
- Face coverings/masks are required at all times on campus.
- Classrooms are set up to maintain appropriate physical distancing.
- All classroom desks have disinfectant supplies, sinks, and desk partitions.
- Supplies and materials will not be shared.
- Frequent handwashing will be required.
- Classrooms are assigned a specific bathroom
- Classrooms will be disinfected before school, between cohorts, and after school.
- All classrooms have been equipped with HEPA HVAC filters.

General Information

- Students will need to bring their computer devices to and from school each day.
- Personal devices are allowed but the school is not responsible if personal items are lost, broken, or stolen.
- Students in the Hybrid model and not in the YMCA will not have recess, breakfast or lunch on campus.
- Drinking fountains are closed so please have your child bring their own water.
- Light snacks are permitted (follow teacher guidelines).
- *Please note that the lunch time for the Hybrid Model is 11:00 am – 11:45 am and the lunch time for those students in Distance Learning is 12:15 pm – 1:00 pm.*

General Information Continued

- Students in the YMCA Distance Learning program will be placed in the afternoon Hybrid Cohorts.
- Students in the YMCA Distance Learning program will have lunch and recess.
- Classroom instruction may occur outdoors when feasible
- Library books may be checked out online. The library will be closed.
- Students who become sick will be directed to the isolation area by the health office.
- Please DO NOT SEND you child to school if he/she is sick or has been exposed to someone with COVID in the last 7 days.
