Arrival Procedures

Supervision begins at 7:30 am each morning and students arrive and report to designated areas or breakfast tables.

Breakfast is served from 7:30 am - 8:00 am- the cafeteria closes at 8:00 am. Breakfast and Lunch are FREE.

Students grades 1-3 report to blacktop Students grades 4-6 report to classrooms Kinder reports to kinder courtyard

Please check your child's health status each day before arriving to school!

Masks must be worn when inside the buildings. Masks are not required outside.

Playing on the structures, running around, or playing with balls is not permitted during arrival.

Students who arrive late (after the bell rings at 8:15 am) will need to report to the front office.

FREE Breakfast and Lunch

- Breakfast and Lunch is FREE and available for all students this school year. *(notify the teacher if you do not want your child to have school breakfast or lunch).*
- Parents may sit with their child for breakfast, but parents will not be able to come on campus during lunchtime.
- *No food sharing!*



Arrival Procedures Cont.

Parents/Guardians dropping off students please use drop-off lane at the front of the school, be patient, and drive slowly.

Please do not drive through the bus loop to drop off students. This area is for busses only!

Parents/Guardians may wait with their child but will not be allowed to enter the classrooms.

Parents/Guardians must keep younger siblings in strollers or with you at all times.

Walk bikes and/or scooters when on campus - students must wear helmets. Heelies are not allowed.

Gates will be locked at 8:30 am each day!

Do not bring PETS on campus!

Campus Daily Procedures

Students may be asked to wash their hands or use hand sanitizer upon entering the classroom.

Students will be required to wear masks when indoors only.

Students will stay with the same cohort/s throughout most of the day.

Students will be assigned seating and/or tables in the classrooms, during VAPA, and during lunchtime.

Students should bring their own water bottles and label them with their name. The water fountains are not available.

Students should put on sunscreen before coming to school.

The school does not offer a delivery service. Make sure your child has their supplies, homework, clothing, etc. before leaving the house. Custodians are not permitted to open classrooms or allow folks on campus after hours to retrieve forgotten or lost items.

Dismissal Procedures

Parents may wait outside their child's classroom door for pickup and must wear masks.

Restrooms will not be open once the dismissal bell rings. Please use the restroom beforehand.

Students may walk home or be picked up at the front of the school in the pick-up, drop-off lane not in the bus loop.

Playing on the structures, running around, or playing with balls is not permitted during dismissal.

Students who have not been picked up by 3:00 pm will be sent to the front of the office.

Outside gates will be locked by 3:00 pm each day.

Do not bring PETS on campus!

Important Information

If your child is absent, you will need to provide a reason for the absence to the Health Office before your child may return to campus.

If your child has *any* symptoms that are associated with COVID19 they will need to quarantine for 14 days and/or provide a negative PCR COVID TEST or have documentation on file in the health office stating chronic condition symptoms.

If your child is quarantined, they will be given an independent study contract with their daily assignments.

If a positive test is reported on campus, a cohort may be shut down and have to quarantine for 14 days.

PLEASE DO NOT SEND YOUR CHILD TO SCHOOL IF THEY ARE NOT FEELING WELL!

Please submit a doctor's note to the health office if your child has any pre-existing health conditions i.e. (migraines, allergies, asthma, etc.)

Safety Protocols

Supplies and materials will be organized and maintained in a manner that limits sharing.

All classrooms have air filters, hand sanitizer, extra masks, and disinfectant wipes.

Classrooms are disinfected at the end of each day.

Classrooms are not required to use plastic desk barriers/dividers.

Please do not send items and/or food to share with the class for birthdays!

Students will have assigned seats in the classroom, in VAPA classes, and at breakfast/lunch.

Teachers will have the option to hold classes outside weather permitting.

UNVACCINATED STUDENT MODIFIED 10 DAY QUARANTINE

For unvaccinated students exposed on campus: If BOTH parties wearing masks (as required by CDPH K-12 indoor guidance) in an indoor classroom setting, unvaccinated students who are **CLOSE CONTACTS** (within 0-6 feet of a positive case for 15 min or more over a 24-hour period) may undergo a modified 10 day quarantine and **CONTINUE TO ATTEND IN PERSON INSTRUCTION** provided ALL of the following are met:

- 1) Remain **ASYMPTOMATIC** (no symptoms of COVID-19)
- 2) Continue to **MASK** appropriately as required
- 3) Undergo at least **TWICE WEEKLY TESTING** during the 10 day period
-With proof of testing/results provided to the school
- 4) Quarantine for ALL extra circular activities (including sports etc) within the community.

- Testing for staff and students will be available at the District Office
 - Monday, July 19 – Friday, July 30
 - 8:00 AM – 4:30 PM
- Testing will be available at each school site on a two-week cadence starting on August 2nd
- When testing starts at school sites on August 2nd, if the parents provide consent through the on-line link for testing, then students will be brought to the testing station at school by the teacher/aide. Parents will not be bringing students to the testing location. It will be an automatic test process every two weeks.
- Both antigen and PCR tests are available.

TESTING

Additional Information

There will be no classroom changes the first 3 weeks of school. Any requests for a classroom change after August 9 must be submitted in writing with the reason for the change to the principal.

All student medications are kept in the health office only - not in classrooms. Contact the office for the procedures.

Notify the school office if your child needs to use the elevator (for physical impairment or disabilities only).

Cell phones and personal electronic devices are allowed but the school is not responsible for personal items that are lost, broken, or stolen and cell phones must be turned off during school unless needed for classroom assignments.

Parent Involvement

Visitors are not permitted in classrooms, on the playground or lunch areas while school is in session at this time.

Once volunteers are permitted on campus, they will need to show proof of vaccination, sign the Volunteer Agreement, and have a current TB Test on file with the office.
