What is DAC/DELAC?



DAC stands for District Advisory Council



As an elected DAC representative for your school, you will be attending monthly meetings with other DAC parent reps from all Chula Vista Elementary School District schools to advise the District on state and federally funded programs, share this information with other parents at your school site, and promote parent participation and leadership.



DELAC stands for District English Learner Advisory Committee

As an elected DELAC representative for your school, you represent parents of students in our District who are Multilingual English Language Learners. You will also be attending monthly meetings with other DELAC parent reps from all Chula Vista Elementary School District schools to advise the District's Governing Board on English Learner Services and Supports, and share this information with parents at your school site.

The **DAC/DELAC Executive Board** will share reports and information.


